NSS–Bolivia: Results

- ⌘ Study supports Bolivia's UNFCCC positions on Forestry and Unilaterality
- ⌘ Proposal for an innovative addition to CDM surplus sharing arrangements – Taxing scheme
- ⌘ Development of a straightforward approval procedure for CDM projects

NSS–Bolivia: Other developments



- ⌘ A standardised National Excel Sheet to calculate incremental costs, GHG effects & costs per ton of CO₂ equivalent
- ⌘ CAF supported CDM activities
- ⌘ Innovative addition: Negotiation training module

- ☒ To ensure **inter-ministerial cohesion of national country policy and strategy** in the field of Climate Change and Clean Development Mechanism;
- ☒ To develop a **prototype programme** that could be replicated in other countries complimenting their respective NSS study project.

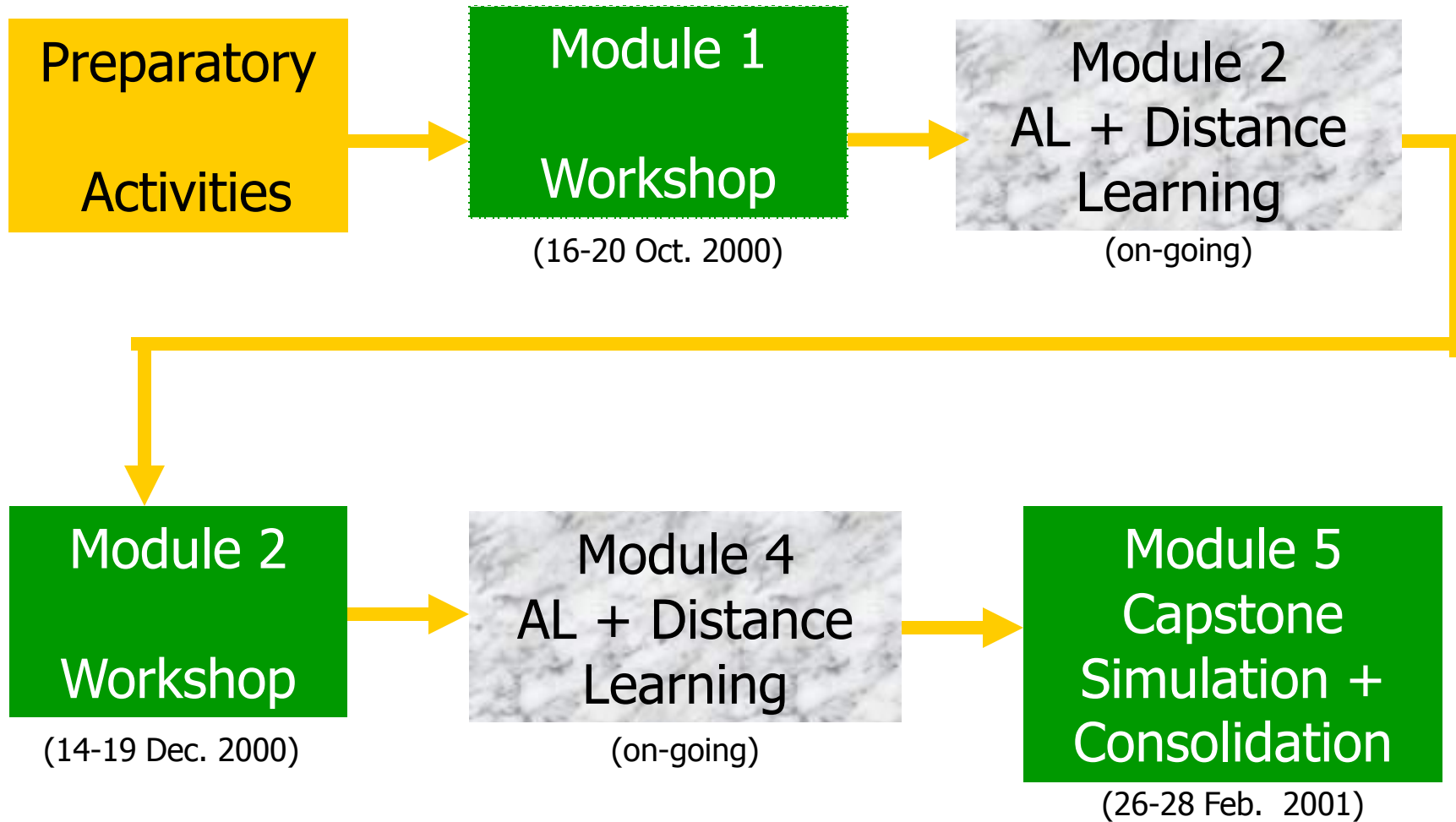

Results - visible

- ⌘ Evaluation by the participants showed an average score of **4.3** (5 best and 1 worst value) regarding the quality, relevance and usefulness of the workshops
- ⌘ 15 participants completed the programme representing government and NGOs
- ⌘ 1 national expert coached to become potential future trainer (TOT)
- ⌘ 4 country specific CC+CDM negotiation simulations developed
- ⌘ Inputs for CC+CDM negotiation strategy of Bolivia

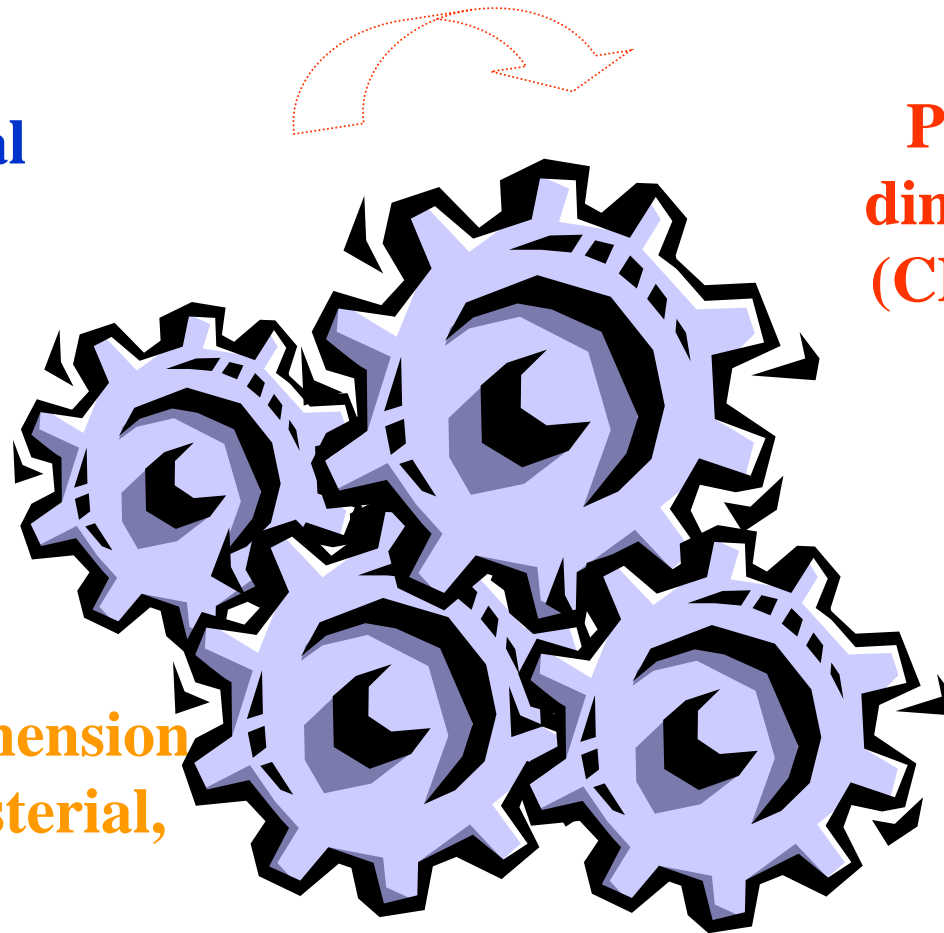
